The first time I walked up to the Church of the Holy Sepulchre in Jerusalem, I was with my seminary classmates winding the dark streets of the old city of Jerusalem. It was night, and we found the doors locked. The next morning, we left the hotel before 5 a.m. —also in the dark—and this time, the doors were opened. I have been in many churches before and after that visit, but there is nothing like that church.

As you walk past the stone slab, which tradition holds to be where Joseph of Arimathea and the women prepared Jesus' body for burial, one turns to the right to see steps leading up to the top of a huge jagged rock.

This is Golgotha, the “place of the skull,” an old stone quarry that the Romans had turned into an execution site. Just outside the city on the main road, the line of crosses provided the many passersby with a not-so-gentle reminder that the Romans were not to be messed with. On that most famous Friday in human history, there were three, each holding the body of a condemned criminal.

Indeed, God chose the most unexpected and the most scandalous means of redeeming the human race. Saint Paul called the cross “folly,” a scandal and stumbling block. It’s not just the crucifixion was the most brutal form of execution the Romans could dream up—though it was. It wasn’t simply that it was designed to be humiliating and dehumanizing—though it was. It was also seen by the Jewish people as a curse: “cursed be anyone who hangs upon a tree,” says the Old Testament book of Deuteronomy. That is why the Jewish leaders were so adamant in having Jesus’ death carried out by the Romans in this way: as proof for his followers that he was a complete fraud, not God’s Son, but rather one cursed by God (see *Galatians 3:13*).

Yet it is part of the essential content of our faith that Jesus was crucified, died, and was buried. Our faith teaches us that the death of Christ on the Cross was not some unfortunate accident, an unforeseen disaster that God had to “fix” through the Resurrection. No, instead, we believe that God, in his inscrutable providence, chose the death of his own Son to be the means by which we reconciled the human race to himself. The Resurrection is, of course, essential—without it, our faith is incomprehensible. But the Resurrection also makes no sense unless Jesus Christ, true God, and true man, really suffered death on that Friday afternoon. Of course, God in himself is supremely perfect and impassible. God simply cannot die. But the Second Person of the Trinity, in taking a human nature to himself, shares our own human nature, one which is by nature subject to death.

The Church’s sacred tradition gives us a glimpse of what happens next. In saying that Jesus “descended into hell,” the Church affirms that with the death of the Son of God, the human race is reconciled to God in a definitive way. For the first time since the fall, human nature is restored to its former dignity and even—O mystery of mysteries!—elevated to heights unknown in the Garden of Eden. Suddenly, the human person is capable of deification—making made like God—not through his own grasping, as Adam and Eve tried, but by being united to Christ.

This unification of the human race in Christ began immediately after his death with the “harrowing of hell,” the release of all those who had died in hope, waiting for the dawn of human redemption. In Dante’s *Divine Comedy*, this is described as a kind of violent break-in. Dante, arriving 1200 years later, still finds remnants of knocked down walls and empty spaces where the just, having met their savior, were taken away to the eternal life of heaven. The power of mercy unleashed on the Cross knows no bounds: it touches every person in every time and place. And while we are free to accept or reject this gift, we know what God desires for each of us. When we look at the Cross, we see what we are worth in God’s eyes. We should stand in wonder and awe of God’s love for us and respond to the grace of conversion and mission he offers each day.
