Dear Friends in Christ,

Today, our parish experiences an event that hasn't happened here for almost a quarter century: the installation of a new pastor. Of course, much has happened in those twenty-four years. Saint Mary Magdalen has grown, hundreds of students have passed through our school and PREP programs, and our beautiful church was constructed and dedicated. The catalyst for that transformational growth has been the Holy Spirit of God, working through our beloved pastor emeritus, Monsignor Ralph Chieffo. I consider it a blessing that my official installation takes place on Monsignor Chieffo's feast day—the feast of the Archangels Michael, Gabriel, and Raphael. As they say in Italy, *buon onomastico*, Monsignor, thank you for the tremendous gift your ministry has been and continues to be to us all.

As we look to the future of our parish, we are filled with hope that God who has begun this good work among us will bring it to completion. As today's Gospel reminds us, we must be diligent in following the Lord's call to conversion and holiness in our lives. There are many different ways that God's grace works in us, as we see in the wonderful diversity of gifts and charisms which have a

home here at Saint Mary Magdalen. At the same time, we must be clear-eyed about our goals: loving God by worshiping him, serving one another, especially the poor and those who are struggling, and making and building up disciples of Jesus Christ. This parish belongs to Jesus Christ and all of us—including this new pastor—who are given the privilege of contributing a small part to building up his Body and extending his Kingdom of justice, love, and peace in our own time and place. For this reason, I will be asking one key question in the months and years to come: who is not here, and why aren't they here?

Indeed, we know there are many who are Catholic but are not regularly part of our worshiping community. There are also many others who are seeking something more in life and who may be experiencing trauma or loneliness. For all of these and many others, our parish can be a home. Amid the darkness of our age, the humble flock of Christ can shine forth with fresh attractiveness and urgency. If we want to be a part of this great work, then we too have to be willing to embrace that conversion which Christ calls us to in the Gospel.

As Pope Francis wrote at the outset of his pontificate: "I dream of a 'missionary option,' that is, a missionary impulse capable of transforming everything, so that the Church's customs, ways of doing things, times and schedules, language, and structures can be suitably channeled for the evangelization of today's world rather than for her self-preservation. The renewal of structures demanded by pastoral conversion can only be understood in this light: as part of an effort to make them more mission-oriented, to make ordinary pastoral activity on every level more inclusive and open, to inspire in pastoral workers a constant desire to go forth and in this way to elicit a positive response from all those whom Jesus summons to friendship with himself."

Dear friends, Saint Mary Magdalen must be a missionary center where God is worshiped in beauty and reverence in the liturgy, such that we may be a community that "goes forth" to embrace those who need to hear—perhaps for the first time or perhaps in a new way—that the God who willed them into existence loves them and made them to share eternity with him in heaven. In a special way, this message is addressed to our young parishioners. My dear young friends, you fill us with great hope that God's Church will continue to grow and flourish here in our corner of Delaware County. Do not be afraid to follow Jesus as a disciple each day. Dear parents, please be open to the possibility that the Lord may be stirring the heart of your son to give his energy and skill to serve him as a priest or that your daughter may wish to dedicate herself to the service of Christ as a consecrated religious.

I am grateful to Kerry Boyle for coordinating many details of this celebration and for preparing our gathering, which will take place in Saint Francis Hall immediately after Mass. Thanks to Deacon Joe Boyle, Ralph Purri, and all who have prepared a beautiful liturgy. Thanks to Bishop McIntyre for being with us and representing Archbishop Pérez. I look forward to walking together with all parishioners as we seek the face of the Lord in Word, Sacrament, and Charity.

We encourage all our ministers to attend or contact the Fr. Eric to obtain information about these new and important protocols for the care and distribution of the Eucharist.




