Most people are familiar with the famous "Halleluja chorus" from Handel's Messiah. Occasionally, choral groups will perform a "pop-up" version around Christmas. Here, our own Mr. Ralph Purri conducts a local presentation of the Messiah, which is coming up soon. The famous chorus is a stirring end to a powerful musical meditation on the person and life of Jesus Christ. My favorite part of that chorus is not the repetitive singing of "Halleluja" but the bridge: "And he shall reign forever and ever." It is that mystery that the Feast of Christ the King evokes in a few weeks. It is also at the heart of the Creed's promise that Christ will "come again in glory to judge the living and the dead."

In this month of November, the themes of the readings often turn to what the Church has traditionally called the "last four things:" death, judgment, heaven, and hell. Admittedly, these are not the most popular topics in common culture. But as winter (slowly) descends upon us, the readings of daily and Sunday Mass evoke the reality that all of us, as Saint Paul says, "will stand beneath the judgment seat of Christ." If you've ever been to the Sistine Chapel at the Vatican and stood under Michelangelo's great fresco, The Last Judgment, you know how small one feels before so profound a mystery. And the mystery is this: that I matter to God.

Yes, me, as small and lowly as I am—my actions matter to the Lord of heaven and earth. They have eternal significance in ways I cannot possibly comprehend. For this reason, this article of the Creed calls us to responsibility because while God wants nothing more than for each of us to enter into the communion of the saints in heaven, he will not force us to enter, either. He made us in his own image, endowed with intellect to know him and will to love him: he will accept the decision we make to his invitation, a decision which is made with our lives.

Of course, Christ is the merciful judge who takes the weight of my own sin upon the Cross. Catholic dogma assures us that Jesus does not judge according to the measure of strict justice. He always responds with mercy and compassion to those who call on him for forgiveness. Sometimes, this forgiveness is accompanied by a period of purification so that one is truly prepared to encounter God in a definitive way and share in his life and love for eternity. This is where the Church's doctrine of purgatory comes from—it is a teaching filled with great hope, recognizing that while the fundamental question of our destiny is answered at death, God, in his mercy, opens a way forward

for those whose fundamental option has been for Christ, even if that choice has been marred by many compromises with sin. Saint Teresa of Calcutta once remarked that she didn't want people to think of her as a saint because she wanted people to pray for the repose of her soul when she died. That's right, Mother Teresa thought she would need prayers! The kind and well-intentioned remarks about someone who has just died "being in heaven" actually can prevent us from doing the most important thing we can for such persons—pray for them, that they may see God face to face for all eternity.

The one who comes as judge of the living and the dead is the same one who steps out upon the waters and says, "Take courage; it is I. Do not be afraid." To know him is to possess eternal life in mystery now, even as we await the fullness of joy in God's kingdom. In these days when autumn leaves fall, and the bareness of winter begins, we know that in Christ alone do we experience the light and peace which God desires for us for all eternity.



The readings are provided with ideas and suggestions for discussing the Gospel.


