

Articles of the Creed

Part Five: Jesus Christ, His Only Son, Our Lord

Twenty-Fifth Sunday in Ordinary Time

September 22, 2024



Dear Friends in Christ,

"And in Jesus Christ, his only Son, our Lord." Here and for the next several weeks, we will meditate upon the sections of the Apostles Creed about Jesus Christ, the Second Person of the Trinity and the Savior of the human race. Even by saying that, one is making an astounding and utterly unique theological claim. It is a claim that Jesus' teaching moved his apostles to assent to, while others rejected him. That same dynamic has been at play in every age since.

Maybe you've seen those bumper stickers that spell out the word "coexist" with various religious symbols. Indeed, the modern world has flattened out human life, creating a sense that every cultural and religious claim is equally valuable and every life situation equally valid and in need of affirmation. Of course, we know that this is simply not true. But even more, the various claims made by those religions are radically different. While it may be possible to speak of "religions" in a sociological sense, the fact is that Christianity makes claims radically different from that of Buddhism, Hinduism, Sikhism, Confucianism, or the natural religions of Africa, Europe, and the early Americas.

What is this radically different claim? That Jesus, a man from the small town of Nazareth in Galilee, a Jewish man born into a relatively poor family, is the eternal Son of God. Just stop and read that sentence again, please. We can get so used to speaking about the elements of the Christian faith that we sometimes fail to recognize how different this is from anything else that has come before or since. Buddhists do not say anything like this about Buddha, nor do Muslims make a claim like this about Muhammad (in fact, Islam offers an explicit rejection of the Christian Trinitarian doctrine). Thanks to pollsters, we often hear about how "self-identified Catholics" think about many issues. But I wonder how many would say yes to this question: "Do you believe with firm faith that Jesus Christ is divine?" Yet, that is the faith of the Church, for all time, from the moment that Mary first gave her "fiat" to the Angel Gabriel and when Peter made his profession of faith, "You are the Christ, the Son of the Living God!" Jesus is called "Christ," which is a translation of the Hebrew word "Messiah," meaning "Anointed One."

Jesus is the one anointed by God to fulfill the prophets' oracles about a coming day of the Lord

in which God himself would come to rescue his people from the slavery of sin. For this reason, Jesus is called "Lord," the one to whom we owe all our allegiance. Again, the term "Lord" is one we use so much as to make it almost meaningless.

However, it can be helpful to consider who the average person during the time of Jesus' public ministry thought of as "Kurios" (Lord): Tiberius Caesar. Yes, Rome's pagan worship had long accommodated the "divinization" of important figures after their death, such as Julius Caesar ("Divus Iulius").

But under the empire begun by Augustus, even a living person—that is, the Emperor—was considered divine as well. Here we see a disastrous combination of religion and the state, in which one is unable to distinguish between impiety and criticism of a human governor. Yet Saint Paul famously shows the falsity of this claim when he says, "no one can say 'Jesus is Lord' except by the Holy Spirit." In other words,

Jesus is the real Kurios! He is the one who alone deserves all our allegiance and loyalty. In worshiping him, we do not worship a vain man making a pathetic claim to divinity; rather, we are worshiping God himself, the eternal Son of God who "for us men and for our salvation, came down from heaven."

Dear friends, there is so much which claims our attention and love in this world. Some are deserving, and some are not. But Jesus Christ, our Lord, the savior of the human race, is worthy of all our love.

Wasn't he the one who said the first and greatest commandment was "to love the Lord your God"?

Only when we have done that can we come to understand how to love others well. Only then can our love be ordered properly. Political questions are important, but we must not place those considerations above the love of God. Pursuing excellence in our profession, or in the arts or sports, is a noble thing, but making an idol out of it leaves us empty. Our love for Christ should be so deep that it brings everything else into focus. I hope all of us can strive to love him in this way as we continue our journey as his faithful disciples.

May the Lord grant you peace!


St. Mary Magdalen Parish is delighted to share the story of our faith and answer questions this fall through *Introduction to Catholicism*.


