Baptismal Preparation Information & Checklist

Below are essential guidelines to help you discern and avoid unnecessary issues as your child's Baptism Day approaches.

Sponsors/Godparents Document & Requirements

First, your sponsor or sponsors must submit their *Letter of Good Standing** to our office **BEFORE** your child's Baptism Date is confirmed.

While having two sponsors at Baptism has become a tradition, one sponsor is adequate. If you have two sponsors, they may not be the same sex.

A Catholic who has not received the sacraments of Confirmation and Holy Eucharist may not be a sponsor.

A Catholic who has defected from the Catholic Church may not be a sponsor.

A non-practicing Catholic may be admitted as a sponsor only if the pastor or minister of the sacrament can determine that the person is in the process of returning to the regular practice of the faith. For this reason, a *Letter of Good Standing (Eligibility)* from the sponsor's parish priest must be submitted within one month of the scheduled date of Baptism.

Members of Eastern Catholic or Orthodox Churches are welcome to serve as sponsors. A member of a Protestant denomination may not serve as a sponsor, though they can be designated as a "Christian Witness."

Baptism Date & Time

Baptisms at St. Mary Magdalen are generally held on Sundays at 1:00 PM. When you schedule the date, an administrator can discuss any exceptions. Complete the [Baptismal Intake Form](#) and submit to our office.

Pre-Jordan Class

Parents, please attend the Pre-Jordan session before your first child's Baptism and take time to discuss it with each other and your chosen sponsors (Godparents). Godparents are also encouraged to attend, but it is not required. Pre-Jordan is the only requirement for preparing for your first child's Baptism. Parents have the option to participate in Pre-Jordan before their child's birth.

Pre-Jordan Classes are generally held once a month on the first Sunday at 12:30 PM in the Gathering Room, which is located off the main narthex. No formal or advance registration is required.
