ADVENT MEDITATION SERIES

Come, Lord Jesus

Dear Friends in Christ,

*Come, thou long expected Jesus
born to set thy people free
From our fears and sins release us
Help us find our rest in thee.*

On this day, hymns like the familiar one quoted above greet us as we light the first violet candle and begin once again the Season of Advent and a new liturgical year.

The key word of these first weeks of Advent is *Maranatha*—Come, Lord Jesus. In singing and praying this way, we echo the voice of the first Christians, who, even in the first decades after the Resurrection, were already making this heartfelt prayer. After all, the last words of the Bible are “Amen. Come, Lord Jesus! (Rev. 20:21)”

Yet, do we mean it when we say these prayers? Are we not all—and I’m preaching to myself here—more or less satisfied with life as it is? Sure, we often get upset about politics and world affairs; maybe a job isn’t going as well as we’d hoped, or there are strains and tensions in families. But really, in the end, we are the most affluent and powerful people who have ever lived. Our country’s economy is the envy of the world. In our community, we live in safe and comfortable homes, far from the arenas of war in Ukraine and the Middle East and even far removed from the rough streets of places like Kensington.

So, then, is “Come, Lord Jesus,” just a nice thing to say, a seasonal tradition like listening to Bing Crosby belt out “White Christmas?” Or is it the measure of what it means to be a Christian?

When we say those words and mean them, we are acknowledging the constant nearness of Christ. No one is far from God. All we have to do is invite him into our lives and homes. We have to be like Mary and Joseph,

who welcomed Christ even though it meant a radical reorientation of life. So often, we prefer to settle for the fragile and imperfect false peace that the world offers rather than the happiness and peace which Christ alone can bring. The prayer “Come Lord Jesus” has an immediate fulfillment in the Eucharistic sacrifice, when Jesus himself really does come among us under the appearance of bread and wine. In other words, the coming of Jesus is something that we should beg for earnestly every day—and recognize the amazing ways God answers it—every day.

Affluence and comfort don’t last forever. But the mercy of God does. (*I invite you to check out information about our upcoming Day of Mercy on page 4.*) This Advent, we ask the Lord to teach us how to receive him and how to live with an awareness of his closeness to us. We can pray “Come Lord Jesus” and mean it—come into our hearts, our lives, and our world, which, despite a veneer of happiness, is often full of sorrow and division. If we live this way, we will have nothing to fear when he comes again in glory and majesty.

May the Lord grant you peace!

REGARDING THE CANONIZATION OF BLESSED CARLO ACUTIS
AND BLESSED PIER GIORGIO FRASSATI IN 2025**

My heart was filled with great joy to learn that Pope Francis will canonize Blessed Carlo Acutis and Blessed Pier Giorgio Frassati as saints next year!

This news ushers in great celebration for the Universal Church and especially for young Catholics. Blessed Carlo will be the first saint from the Millennial Generation and Blessed Pier Giorgio is a model of Missionary Discipleship for young adults leading busy lives while searching for true fulfillment.

Blessed Carlo, who died in 2016 at age 15, is an inspiration for children and adolescents through his passion for using technology to evangelize and share his devotion to Jesus in the Eucharist. Blessed Pier Giorgio, who died in 1925 at age 24, is a model for young adults through his dedication to serving the poor in urban areas while balancing university studies, social activism, and daily prayer.

Both of these saintly young men reflect the call for today’s youth and young adults to live out their Catholic faith with courage, compassion, and divine love. Blessed Carlo, in particular, holds a special place in the heart of our local Church. We were blessed to host his mother, Antonia Salvano Acutis, last fall when she spoke about her son’s love and devotion to Jesus in the Eucharist at our Eucharistic Congress. Her reflections filled us with wonder and awe. They still resonate as we strive to follow in the footsteps of her son.

I pray that the inspiration flowing from Blessed Carlo and Blessed Pier Giorgio will fuel the zealous hearts of our young people to serve others with Christ as their model. All Catholics should rejoice, as I do, in the canonization of saints for our time and for those who will inherit the Church on earth.
