In ten short days, it will be Christmas Day. Does that sentence fill you with dread or joy? As I mentioned in my homily last week, "Holidays, Inc." can fill us with anxiety as we max out our schedules (and our credit cards!) trying to make the season "perfect." But it doesn't have to be that way!

The good news is that Christ has come; yes, Christ has been born for us in history. Our world can never be the same. It is that fact which should be the source of all the joy and festivity of these days. That is why on this Third Sunday of Advent, the Introit of the Mass bids us "REJOICE!" ("Gaudete") at the nearness of Christ, the

Incarnate Word of God. The priest dons rose vestments to add to the anticipation as well. It is a kind of return to spiritual childhood: just as children become almost giddy in anticipation of Christmas morning, so we too can allow ourselves to be filled with joy that, indeed, the greatest gift we will ever receive has come and will come again.

At the same time, the shortness of the Advent season bids us to that urgency to conversion. In other words, we need to be properly disposed to receive such a great gift. We must enter into the silence and prayer to which these final weeks of Advent call us. In particular, I encourage you to make the Sacrament of Penance part of your spiritual preparation in these final weeks.

Now, I know what some of you might think: going to Confession is about as pleasant as getting a root canal done. Of course, no one likes to admit when they're wrong—I certainly don't. But if we're honest with ourselves, we know that our world is not what it is meant to be, nor how God has ordered it to be. And that disordering of the world is a result of sin—not just my sin, of course, but mine too! What are we going to do about it? Political and technological solutions are not the answer—they often make things worse!

God has done something about it: he has sent his Son, born of the Virgin Mary, who on the Cross redeems fallen humanity and inaugurates the new creation. That salvation is made present in our lives in Baptism. But what happens when we fail to live up to that new covenant, which includes the commandment to love one another as Christ has loved us? I know I have walked into confessional in my life filled with dread about the things I would say to the priest. Once, when I was on an eight-day silent retreat in Nebraska, I even made a "general confession" which went back over the previous 20 years or so. Yet, every single time, it was a beautiful and powerful experience. As a priest, I have had the tremendous joy of welcoming back into the state of grace a person who had been away from Confession for many years. There is no more humbling experience for me than that.

When we go to Confession, we aren't merely saying out loud the sins we have committed; instead, we are really confessing the goodness of God, in whose mercy we have great confidence and hope. We bring to the Lord not the gift of our sins, but the gift of true

sorrow for those sins and the firm resolution to make amends and live in a manner worthy of our Christian

call. That act begins with God's grace, and in the absolution of the priest, our contrition is made perfect, our sins are forgiven, and we are filled with the grace to begin anew the journey of discipleship. Is there any greater gift we can receive this Christmas?


